Kibeho, Rwanda is the place of the first Marian apparition in Africa, which was recognized by the Church in 2001. Our Lady came to remind us of the Gospel of her Son. In her messages for the world she pleads: Pray, convert your heart, give deep testimony of the Christian suffering, pray the Rosary of the 7 Sorrows which means to love God and your neighbor.

FATHER LESZEK, MIC

Father Leszek is a member of the Marian Fathers and has served the Rwandan Church for the past 24 years. With his community, he has accomplished many mission projects in Rwanda. He is working in Kibeho for the last 10 years in the Marian Formation Center, one mile from the Shrine of Our Lady. His community works for the Spiritual and Marian development and the social works including the building of a Primary School, a Medical Center, Bakery and other charity works.
